

Each week minimal weighting is used to ensure the data set is nationally representative based on region, church size, and denomination.

The margin of error for this study is calculated per week based on the sample size (n=). The margin of error for this project ranges from 5.35% to 7.65%







As your church considers plans for re-entry for worship services, which of the following has been most influential on your decisions?










Which of the following best describes the emotional state of your congregation?








- It was somewhat higher (up 1-20%)








In the last month, how often, if ever, have you felt lonely?








In the last month, how often have you felt overwhelmed?


Do you have someone you can confide in—someone who you would feel comfortable sharing your feelings or personal stories with?






What gives you confidence your church will survive, and you will be able to reopen?


Among churches that offered an Easter service








Do you think your church will continue to provide digital options for worship services once social distancing is no longer required?





How is your church measuring the effectiveness of your online worship services? Select the option below which has been most helpful.






Does your church use a multiplier to help measure "attendance" for a worship service?



Average multiplier: 2.31 (base: use a multiplier)





About how many people, if any, have reached out to your church in the past month, seeking help to cope with the current health and economic crisis?




How well equipped do you personally feel to help someone from your congregation deal with matters relating to mental or emotional health?






Which of the following best describes how your church is participating in communion during the COVID-19 crisis?






